TRIDENT UNITED WAY ENDOWMENT

Trident United Way's endowment exists to meet the urgent needs of Tri-County children and families today, while simultaneously investing resources to address the future challenges of tomorrow. The endowment fund consists of the three categories below:

GREATEST AND EMERGING COMMUNITY NEEDS

This unrestricted bucket contains dedicated resources for future Trident United Way board leadership to use in addressing the most pressing needs in the community, whatever they may be. This fund is available for the board to use as it sees fit.

HELPING CHILDREN AND FAMILIES THRIVE

This funding is set aside specifically for supporting Tri-County children, families, and seniors through core mission programs and services. These services include Centers for Strong Families, early learning initiatives, pre-school programs, food access and hunger relief programs, housing, healthcare, transportation, and special initiatives in support of veterans and individuals with disabilities. *Specific funding initiatives will evolve as community priorities change. Any funds endowed for a specific program that becomes obsolete shall be redirected to a closely aligned purpose, even as program models and goals shift.

INCREASING CAPACITY AND INNOVATION FOR TOMORROW

This funding is designated for the essential organizational needs and human capital of Trident United Way and its agency partners. Resources set aside for overhead and administrative expenses are crucial to offset inflation, provide salaries and benefits, and prevent disruption of mission delivery during times of revenue decline. Whether it be to endow a particular position within the organization, or cover building repairs, these funds will free up annual fundraising efforts to be used for pressing mission purposes, including training and development, and supporting best practices.
