

Trident United Way – 2023 Day of Caring Photo Contest Rules

Official Rules

- By participating in the contest, each participant agrees as follows in this document.
- Please refer to the Trident United Way General Contest Rules in addition to this set of specific contest rules. The General Contest Rules can be found on our website at this link <https://www.tuw.org/contest-rules>.
- Contest begins at 7am on 11/15/2023 and runs through 4pm on 11/20/2023. Winner will be randomly selected after 4pm on 11/20/2023, and will be notified by email prior to winner announcement on social media on 11/22/2023.
- Contest is on Facebook, Instagram and LinkedIn only
- The name of an individual or organization who posts or shares a post, tags Trident United Way and uses #DaysOfCaring in the post or share will be entered into a random selection drawing.

Eligibility and Limitations

- All participants in 2023 Days of Caring are eligible to participate, including but not limited to individual volunteers, volunteers who participate on a team, companies, agency staff and agencies. Employees of Trident United Way and their families are not eligible.
- Post must tag Trident United Way and use the designated hashtag to be eligible for contest.
- This contest is not sponsored by or associated with Facebook, Instagram or LinkedIn.
- Unless otherwise specified only legal U.S. residents who are 18 years of age at the time of entry are eligible to participate in company contests.
- Unless otherwise stated in the official contest rules, Trident United Way will allow only one (1) entry per person or organization, only one (1) prize per person or organization for each contest, and only one (1) prize valued at \$600 or more per household within any six (6) month period.
- If a contestant receives multiple and/or irregular votes from the same user or users, regardless of the source, Trident United Way reserves the right to disqualify the contestant in its sole discretion.
- Employees and immediate family of Trident United Way, the contest's participating sponsors, and their advertising agencies, are not eligible to participate and win. The term "immediate family" includes spouses, siblings, parents, children, grandparents, and grandchildren, whether as "in-laws," or by co-habitation, or other family extension, and any other persons residing at the same household whether or not related.
- Previous year's winners are not eligible.

Prize(s)

- The Prize for Trident United Way – 2023 Day of Caring Photo Contest is \$50 Panera Bread gift card, furnished by Covelli Enterprises, Franchisee of Panera Bread, LLC.
- Prize can be redeemed at any time

- Prizes awarded are “as-is”.
- The prize(s) that may be awarded to the eligible winner(s) are not transferable, redeemable for cash, or exchangeable for any other prize(s).
- All prizes must be redeemed from Trident United Way within ninety (90) days of the contest end date unless otherwise stated in the contest’s official rules.
- Proper identification must be presented by any winner to claim prize. If representing a company or agency, a badge or business card will be accepted. As a condition to receiving the prize, any potential winner must complete and sign a Winner’s Affidavit and Release, releasing the Company, their affiliates, members, directors, officers, and all employees from all liability in connection with winner’s participation in the contest, acceptance, and use or non-use of the prize.
- If a winner cannot be contacted or is disqualified for any reason, Trident United Way reserves the right to determine an alternate winner or not to award that winner’s prize, in the sole discretion of the Company.
- If it is determined that a candidate is not eligible for receipt of a prize, in the Company’s sole judgement and discretion, another candidate may be selected for eligibility consultation and this process will continue until such time as an eligible candidate is found. In the unlikely event that no candidates are found to meet the specification, then the prize will go unawarded.
- Trident United Way and affiliated sponsors are not liable for the failure of any third-party prizes.
- Trident United Way reserves the right to not award third-party prizes to contestants who have, in the sole judgment of the Company, failed to comply with terms of previous contests run by the Company.

Publicity; Use of Personal Information

- By participating, where allowed by law, all participants and winner(s) grant Trident United Way exclusive permission to use their names, characters, photographs, voices, videotape, and likenesses in connection with promotion of this and other contests and waive any claims to royalty, right, or remuneration for such use.
- By participating in the contest, where allowed by law, participants agree that Trident United Way may disclose personal information obtained from participants in the contest to third parties and use such information for marketing and other purposes.

Consumer Created Content
